NLC wins Gold Award for its Annual Report

The Northern Land Council (NLC) has won the Gold Award in the General category of the annual Australasian Reporting Awards for its 2008 Annual Report, and is a finalist in the Report of the Year category. It is the second time in a row that the NLC has won such an award.

NLC Chief Executive, Kim Hill said that he was very pleased at winning this Award because it reflects the NLC'S commitment to the principles of good governance.

“The NLC is a big organisation which has a broad range of roles and responsibilities, and winning this Award recognises the hard work of all my staff, and the complex and challenging conditions that we all operate under.

“So I am happy to accept this Award on the NLC’s behalf. I am also hopeful that we will win in the Report of the Year category.”

Mr Hill also said that this is the second time in a row that NLC has entered these Awards and won.

“We entered these Awards for the first time last year and we won Silver for our 2007 Annual Report – so we’ve obviously improved our reporting requirements – and I’m also very pleased about that.”

The Award will be received tonight in Melbourne by NLC Chief Executive, Kim Hill and NLC Deputy Chairman, Samuel Bush-Blanasi.
