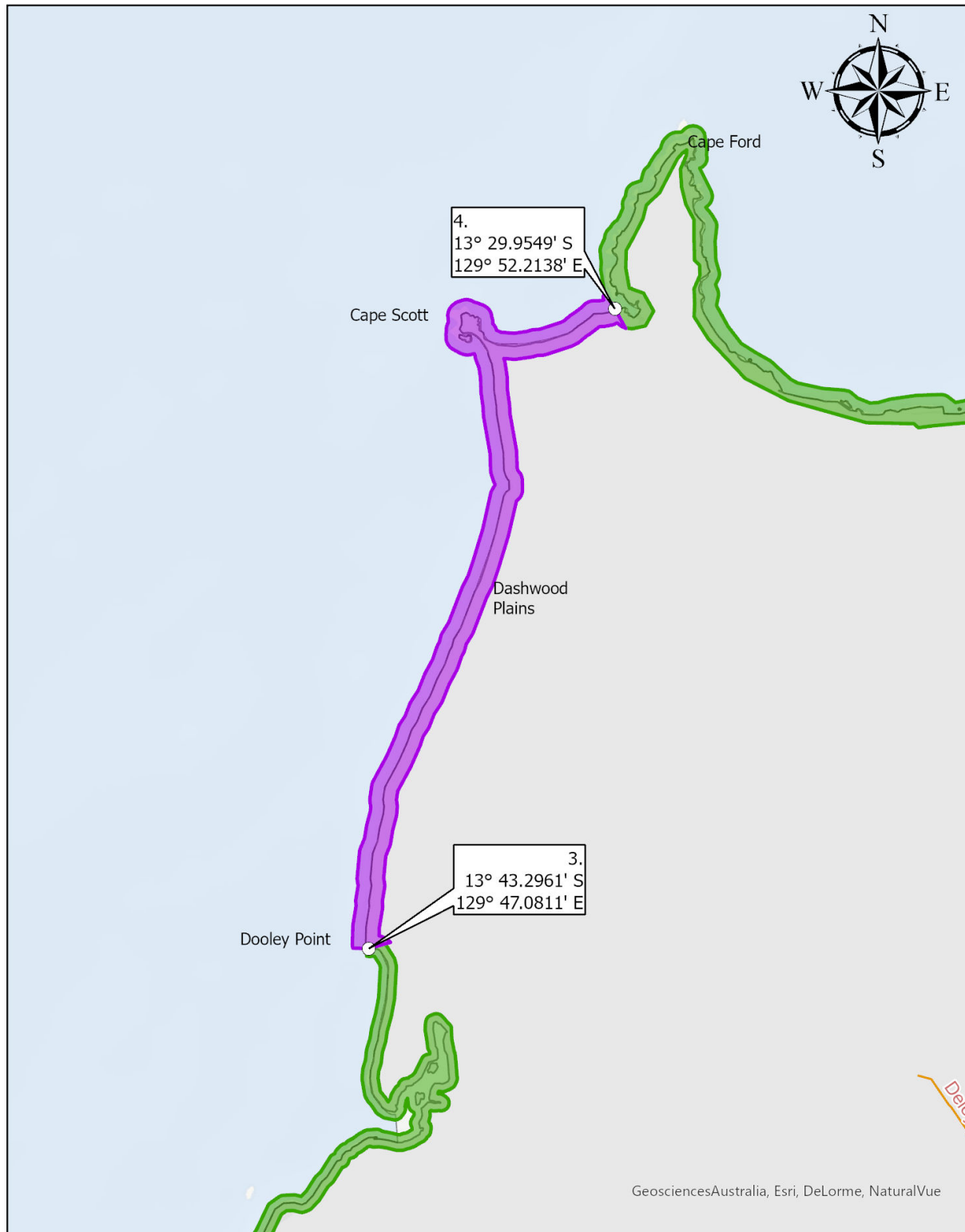


Fishing Access Zone 2



- Permit area
- Long-Term Agreement – Open Access
- Aboriginal Land Trust



Permit area applies to the intertidal zone along the highlighted coastline and the waters to the tidal extent of intersecting waterways. The intertidal zone is that area between the Mean Low Water Mark and the Mean High Water Mark. The Mean Low Water Mark is the average position of the water at low tide. The Mean High Water Mark is the average position of the water at high tide.

Zone range

From the northernmost point of the Long Term Access area – Port Keats, near Dooley Point (13° 43.2961' S 129° 47.0811' E) to the southernmost point of the Long Term Access area – Anson Bay, area near Cape Ford (13° 29.9549' S 129° 52.2138' E).
