Permit area applies to the intertidal zone along the highlighted coastline and the waters to the tidal extent of intersecting waterways. The intertidal zone is that area between the Mean Low Water Mark and the Mean High Water Mark. The Mean Low Water Mark is the average position of the water at low tide. The Mean High Water Mark is the average position of the water at high tide.



Zone range

From Braithwaite Point (11° 46.2652' S 133° 56.4708' E) to the start of the Closed Seas Area at Cape Stewart (11° 57.6461' S 134° 43.6541' E).
